4. Additional Terms and Conditions
4.1. Coordination of Key Events
The Client agrees to inform the Photographer or an appointed representative of important events during the wedding (e.g., bouquet toss, cake cutting, speeches, etc.) to ensure adequate preparation.
4.2. Capturing Guest Photographs
The Photographer will make reasonable efforts to capture photographs of as many guests as possible; however, the cooperation of guests in having their photo taken may affect the final coverage.
4.3. Precedence in Photographs
The Client agrees that the Photographer shall be given priority in capturing photographs over guests with cell phone cameras or other devices. The Photographer cannot be held liable for the lack of photographs or compromised quality if guests interfere with the Photographer's work.

The Client agrees to provide a meal for the Photographer if the Photographer's coverage extends beyond five (5) hours. The Photographer has provided information about any food

allergies or dietary restrictions below:

4.5. Location Limitations

The Client acknowledges that the Photographer's coverage may be restricted by the rules and regulations of the ceremony and reception venues (e.g., restrictions on flash photography in certain venues).

5. Copyright

The Photographer shall retain the copyright of all photographs taken during the wedding. However, the Photographer grants the Client permission to make copies of the images for personal use by the Client and their family and friends. Any commercial use, sale, or publication of the photographs requires the prior written consent of the Photographer.

6. Cancellation

6.1. By Client

The Client may cancel this Contract at any time before the wedding date. In the event of cancellation, the Client shall be entitled to a refund of all monies paid, excluding the non-refundable deposit.

6.2. By Photographer

The Photographer reserves the right to cancel this Contract at any time. In such an event, the Photographer shall provide a suitable replacement Photographer, subject to the Client's approval. Alternatively, the Photographer shall refund all payments made by the Client, including the non-refundable deposit.

7. Dispute Resolution and Legal Fees

In the unlikely event of a dispute arising from this Contract, the Parties agree to attempt mediation. If mediation fails to resolve the dispute, and legal action ensues, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover its legal fees, including attorney's fees.

8. Severability

If any provision of this Contract is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

9. Legal and Binding Contract

This Contract is legally binding between the Parties as stated above and is effective on the date of signing. Both Parties affirm that they have the authority to enter into this Contract.

10. Limitation of Liability

Neither party shall be liable to the other party or any third party for any damages resulting from any aspect of this Contract, including but not limited to, loss of revenue, anticipated profit, or any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages.
